








View My Auctions



- 1. Log in to the platform.
- 2. Expand the navigation menu and select **Sourcing -> Auctions -> My Auctions**.






View My Auctions



3. In the My Auctions area, you will see a list of auctions you've been invited to. The title, status, start time, end time, and buyer organization will be displayed for each auction.






The Auction Monitor icon will only appear in the Monitor column for auctions with a **Running, Suspended, Terminated, Not Awarded,** or **Awarded** status.


1.2 AUCTION DETAILS



Auction Details



1. Before being able to access the Auction Details, you need to download and confirm the **Auction**Participation Rules:






Auction Details



 Once you confirmed the Auction Participation Rules, you can view the Auction Settings (e.g., Bidding and Awarding Rules) and Buyer Attachments.






1.3 AUCTION MONITOR



Auction Monitor



- 1. One hour prior to the auction start date, the status of the auction is changing from "Published" to "To Start". In consequence, the Auction Monitor can be accessed earliest 60 minutes before the event's starting time.
- 2. Access your auction that is going to start.
- 3. Click on the "Auction Monitor" icon in the top right corner.






Auction Monitor



- 1. The Auction Monitor shows your connection strength.
- 2. To see more details on each individual auction, click on the icon to expand.
- 3. The information displayed will be dependent on the auction format and auction settings.
- 4. You can also star favorite auctions to keep them at the top of the list.
- 5. Use the back button for closing the Auction Monitor.






1.4 ENTER AND SUBMIT BIDS



Enter and Submit Bids



- 1. For submitting a bid, the auction must have the status "Running".
 - The following explanation utilizes the example of a Dutch Auction.
- 2. As soon as a price is reached that you are willing to accept, click "SUBMIT".



3. Click the "Confirm" button in order to send your new bid or click "Cancel" to delete the entered bid.






Enter and Submit Bids




4. Once the new bid is submitted, a pop-up will notify you that the bid has been successfully accepted.



All your bids are being processed and evaluated by the system. If your bid is rejected, you will receive the corresponding error message.


1.5 AUCTION END



Auction End



► The suppliers who accepted the bid will get the information that the auction has ended with or without concurrent bids, the other ones will get a notification that the auction has ended.





Auction End



- ► After the awarding has been performed (status: "Awarded"), you are able to access the so called "Bid History". Here you can review your submitted bids of the event. The winning bid is indicated by a trophy symbol.
- ► After the event you will be contacted regarding awarding decision or next steps depending on the number of submitted bids and the auction type.



► You can check the status of your auctions at any time in the My Auctions area:






1.6 SUSPENDED AUCTION



Suspended Auction



- ▶ If it is needed, the auction can be suspended by the buyer.
- ▶ You will receive information about next steps via the message function.





2. MANAGE AUCTION MESSAGES




Manage Auction Messages



To communicate with the buyer during the auction, you should use the message feature on the Auction Monitor.

Create Messages:

- 1. Go to the "Messages" tab on the Auction Monitor.
- 2. Type your message into the relevant box.
- 3. Click "Send" to submit your message to the buyer.







View Received Messages:

When the buyer replies or sends you a message during an auction, it will be displayed in the

"Messages" tab on the Auction Monitor.


